

## CAMPSITE REGULATIONS

Status: October 2023

Dear Guests, in the interest of nature, the environment, and the people who wish to relax, campsite rules are necessary. We hope for your understanding and that you will enjoy your stay.

1. Access to the campsite is only permitted after all persons have registered. Arriving guests and visitors must therefore register at reception. This does not apply to guests who have already received their access card.
2. Guests are required to park motorhomes, caravans, or tents only on the assigned pitches. Failure to comply or unauthorized use of other pitches may result in the requirement to vacate the incorrectly occupied pitches.
3. Guests and visitors must pay pitch fees, overnight fees, and additional charges (e.g., tourist tax) according to the current price list.
4. The vehicle registration document must be clearly displayed behind the windshield.
5. Pitches are rented solely for camping or recreational purposes. Residential tenancy law does not apply, and residential use is prohibited.
6. The campsite is located within the Southeast Rügen Biosphere Reserve. Therefore, all conduct must comply with the reserve's regulations. Breaking off branches and twigs from trees and shrubs is prohibited. Any interference with the flora and fauna is forbidden, as many protected species are native to the area. Campfires or open fires are strictly prohibited on the entire campsite, including the beach. Barbecuing is permitted on the campsite, but only when no forest fire danger levels are in effect in the Mönchgut-Granitz district.
7. Permanent structures of any kind are prohibited on the campsite and will be removed at the builders' expense and invoiced accordingly.
8. All facilities and equipment must be treated with care. If you damage anything, please report it immediately to reception or another member of the campsite staff.
9. It is strictly forbidden to dispose of chemical toilet waste in the toilets. Please use the designated disposal points at the sanitary facilities. Guests who do not comply with this regulation to protect the environment and nature will be prosecuted and expelled from the campsite. As we are located in a protected reserve, we ask for your understanding.
10. For environmental reasons, we have a waste separation system and ask you to observe and adhere to it. The waste is disposed of by authorized companies from the local waste management authority. Please actively participate in waste separation and use the yellow bags for the Green Dot recycling program available on site. Glass and paper do not belong in the general waste; separate containers are provided for these items. Separate containers are also provided for batteries and rechargeable batteries.
11. Digging pits on the campsite is prohibited. All wastewater can be disposed of at our sanitary facilities. Stringing up any kind of rope or cord on the campsite is also prohibited. If these get caught on trees and bushes, they damage the plants and pose a safety hazard to everyone.
12. Washing cars or caravans is prohibited on the entire campsite. This should be done in the designated car wash bays at petrol stations.
13. Parking your vehicle is only permitted in the designated parking spaces.

14. Each user of an electrical connection is responsible for the power supply and plug. We assume that the electrical system in your vehicle or caravan is in perfect working order. Guests are liable for any damage caused by improper electrical connections.
15. Gas cylinders must not weigh more than 11 kg. When using gas cylinders, we assume that the gas system between the cylinder and your caravan/motorhome/tent complies with all legal and technical requirements. Pipes and gas systems/cylinders must be operated correctly, regularly maintained, and inspected accordingly.
16. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times on the campsite. This also applies to the beach, as it is part of the campsite grounds. Outside the campsite, the regulations of the state of Mecklenburg-Vorpommern (HundehVO M-V) of July 11, 2022, apply. Bringing dangerous dogs as listed in the HundehVO M-V or dogs known to bite is prohibited. Showering animals in the sanitary facilities is strictly forbidden; a dog shower is available at sanitary building 1.
17. Enclosing pitches with ditches, fences, or other enclosures is prohibited. Care must be taken to ensure that no one is endangered or disturbed by tent pegs, guy lines, or other equipment.
18. The use of drones on the campsite grounds is prohibited.
19. Quiet hours are from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM and from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM. The campsite gates are closed during these times and may only be opened in emergencies. Music must be kept at a low volume. For the comfort of all campers, please refrain from loud conversations during these quiet hours. Quiet hours may be lifted in exceptional circumstances.
20. Driving any type of vehicle is permitted only on designated paths and roads at walking pace. Please be mindful of the safety of children playing here!
21. Guests are responsible for tidying their pitches before departure. If the campsite requires any work to restore the pitch to a satisfactory condition, we reserve the right to charge the guest for these costs.
22. The campsite is for recreation. Operating a business, commercial rentals, and/or commercial displays require written permission from management.
23. Management and staff are authorized, in exercising their right to control access to the premises, to refuse entry to or remove individuals from the site if necessary to maintain safety and order or in the interest of other guests. Intoxicated guests or individuals arriving at the campsite will be refused entry.
24. Campsites must be vacated by 11:00 AM on the day of departure.

The general terms and conditions of Stranddörp campsite apply.
